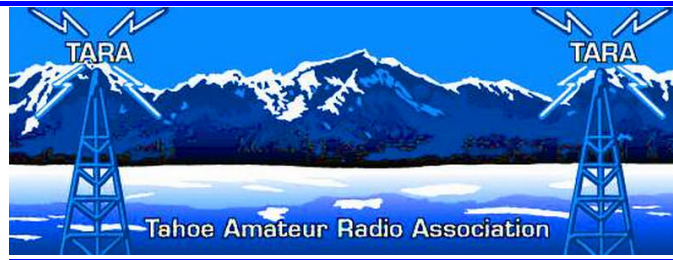

## **HAM CRAM and LICENSE Exam Session Earn your Amateur Radio Technician License in ONE DAY!**

The “CRAM” consists of reviewing (reading) all the questions in the Q&A license manual followed by reading the correct answer ONLY. Upon completion, the exam is immediately administered to the class.

The Cram and Exam will require your attendance until 4:30PM

TARA will provide a FREE lunch – sandwich, chips and water or bring your own

This method has proven itself with over a 90% pass rate IF the participants have studied the material before. In depth pre-study is preferred, but just familiarizing yourself with the questions and answers will greatly benefit your chances for success.



We will be using the A.R.R.L Tech Q&A 6th Edition for the class read through. The Book is available at [www.arrl.com](http://www.arrl.com) and [amazon.com](http://amazon.com) for \$17.50. A kindle version is also available.

Again, it is highly recommended that you purchase a book and take the time to read and study the contents. The “Cram” works well at “imprinting” the exam answers, but the more you expose yourself to the structure of the question and answers, the better your chances.

**Please Note:** *A valid legal photo ID is required. The FCC requires us to collect either your Social Security Number OR a Federal Registration Number with your license application. To obtain an FRN, go to [www.fcc.gov](http://www.fcc.gov) and click on CORES in the left hand column. Follow the directions to obtain your FRN. Be sure to have this number in your possession before attending the session if you'd rather not give out your SS#.*

**ALSO:** The “HAM CRAM” is free. The cost of the actual exam is \$15. If time permits, a re-test may be offered but will require an additional \$15.
